### **LEAD TECHNICIAN - INSTALLATIONS**

#### **PRIMARY FUNCTION:**

- Install AVL (Audio, Video and Theatrical Lighting) systems in commercial buildings and performance venues.
- Provide training and service to client on new and existing AVL equipment.
- Lead AVL installations, interface with ALS Project Managers and Designers, lead crew of 2-5 technicians.

#### **DESCRIPTION:**

- Install, maintain, troubleshoot and repair AVL systems, using entertainment industry best practices
- Accurately and timely document quality standards and project work
- Direct technicians and on job site project workflow; assign them appropriate tasks per job specifications
- Maintain installation shop area in warehouse.
- Work with client's electrical and general contractors.
- Assist ALS Production Dept. on events periodically.
